We are delighted to have your child join us for SeaWorld Day Camp. We'd like to give you an idea of what we have planned for this week. We encourage you to discuss with your child what they did at camp each day.

Shamu Adventurers

Shamu Adventurers will become pirates, safari leaders, polar explorers, scuba divers, and whale watchers in search of marine life adventures. Animal information will be reinforced with SeaWorld-themed games, songs, activities, and crafts. On various days of the week your camper will see these animals:

- temperate and tropical-themed animals including coral reefs, kelp beds, tide pools, sea turtles, shore crabs, South American parrots, warm water sharks, and Caribbean flamingos
- wild-themed animals including sea lions, piranha, and bat rays
- polar-themed animals including Antarctic penguins, arctic puffins, beluga whales, walruses, and polar bears
- whale watching-themed animals including killer whales and bottlenose dolphins

Your camper is in for a week of fun in the sun. In addition to the camp activities, we will see shows and visit animal areas and attractions like the Bay of Play. Campers will visit areas in the park where they may get wet daily.

We recommend you send the following for your camper every day:

- clothes that can get wet and that dry quickly
- sunscreen (applied at home and reapplied by camper at lunch)
- shoes that can get wet and not slip—**no "flip flops" please**
- sack lunch daily (two snacks are provided each day)

Campers will be escorted at all times by SeaWorld Day Camp counselors making for a safe and enjoyable time.
