## **Reservation:**

1. We cannot guarantee that your preferred date will be available at the time you make your reservation, as space is limited and venues fill to capacity quite quickly. We recommend choosing several dates that work for group to attend.
2. Dates listed above are for groups of 7 to 24 participants, which include both Girl Scouts and female chaperones.
3. Girl Scout Mix-in Sleepovers are for Girl Scouts in the 2<sup>nd</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> grades and female chaperones only.
4. At the time you make your reservation \$25 nonrefundable deposit is required to hold the date for the group with the remaining balance is due two weeks later.
5. To make your reservation please call (800) 25-SHAMU x42. Office hours are 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday thru Friday.
6. All Sleepovers above include: dinner, educational activities, snack, sleeping venue, a hot breakfast, and free SeaWorld admission the day after your Sleepover.

*Programs, venues, themes, dates, and fees are subject to change. Our priority is to deliver your preferred sleeping venue; however, animal needs and park events occasionally require us to relocate Sleepovers. Selected Sleepovers require a 25 participant minimum and are subject to cancellation. Sleepovers proceed during inclement weather; however, activities and meals will be relocated. Sleepover fees will not be refunded or events rebooked due to inclement weather.*



# SLEEPOVER CANCELLATION POLICY FOR PUBLIC MIX-IN SLEEPOVERS

**A nonrefundable deposit of \$25 per group is required at the time of reservation with remaining balance due two weeks later.**

**Once payment has been received, \$25 per person is nonrefundable.**

If written notice of cancellation is received prior to 6 weeks before session, then 100% of Sleepover payment (less the \$25 per person fee) will be refunded.

If cancellation occurs between 4-6 weeks prior to session, then 50% of remaining fee is refunded (less the \$25 per person fee).

If cancellation occurs less than 4 weeks preceding the session, then the spot is lost and no cash will be reimbursed.

The entire group may reschedule to an open session within the same calendar year no later than 6 weeks before their schedule date (less the \$25 per person fee).

Public Mix-In Sleepovers include Girl Scouts of the USA Mix-In, Boy Scouts of America Mix-In, and "Pod" Mix-In Sleepovers.

**All cancellation requests must be in written form from the main contact of the reservation\* and faxed to (619) 226-3634. It is the main contact's responsibility to call SeaWorld to verify the fax has gone through. Please call (800) 257-4268 extension 42 to reach a Sleepover Reservationist. SeaWorld cannot accept cancellation requests from anyone other than the main contact.**

*\*The main contact of the reservation is the group leader and the person who initially made the reservation, unless they have relinquished their duties to another person and SeaWorld has this in written form from the original main contact person on file.*
