

## SeaWorld Sleepover Parent/Chaperone Information

**ARRIVAL:** 5:45 p.m. – Education Gate Entrance\* (map on opposite side). Please arrive on time. Entrance doors will close as soon as check-in is completed and will not be admitted in after 6 p.m. If unexpected delays arise the night of your Sleepover please call (619) 666-5476 by 5:30 p.m. to make arrangements with our staff.

Parking fee is not included in the Sleepover Package. Please call (800) 25-SHAMU for current parking fee.

\* All Sleepover participants will be entering and exiting through the Education Gate during the Sleepover Program. There is no re-entry at this gate once participants have exited. For re-entry during the day, groups must exit at Exit Plaza (next to the Main Entrance) and get their hand stamped, then re-enter through the Main Entrance.

<u>DIRECTIONS TO SEAWORLD</u>: From North or South: Exit Interstate 5 onto Sea World Drive. Go west to the park entrance and veer to the right. Proceed to the parking tolls. From East: Exit Interstate 8 West onto Mission Bay drive. Turn right and go over Sports Arena Bridge on Ingraham Street. Take SeaWorld Drive turn-off to Ingraham Street. Make a U-turn at the first light and follow signs to the parking tolls.

**MEALS:** Pre-planned dinner and breakfast are included in the Sleepover package.

**LUGGAGE:** SeaWorld Security may search bags prior to entry. Please plan to store luggage in your vehicle after the Sleepover event.


**BEDTIME:** Dependent upon park hours and activities. Your group's bedtime may be as late as midnight.

**SAFETY:** Shirts and shoes are required at all times before bedtime. Sleepovers are a fully supervised event and members of the SeaWorld Sleepover Team will remain with the group throughout the event. Adults and children are required to stay with their group at all times. SeaWorld Security and Health Services are on duty 24 hours a day.

**DISMISSAL:** When SeaWorld opens the following day, participants will be released to enjoy the day in the park on their own. Our staff will not have contact with the Sleepover group after dismissal. If someone will be joining you after the Sleepover, don't forget to preplan where and when you will meet. Please let your guests know that they can receive a 20% off the General Admission Price at the Will Call and Travel Voucher Window located at the front of the park. They will need to give your group leader's name (the main contact) and the area that the group is sleeping in. For current General Admission prices call (800) 25-SHAMU.
